- Communication: Effectively communicating the message of the Gospel, facilitating seamless information flow within the congregation, and utilizing various media platforms to amplify our impact.



In 2023, two projects were undertaken to provide water for the people as part of our community impact service at Kamonyi in Southern Province and also in Gasabo district.


The Planning and MEAL (Monitoring, Evaluation, Accountability & Learning)

Cell Groups

Recognizing the importance of community and discipleship, the Cell Group Team facilitates small group gatherings where members can cultivate deeper relationships, study God's Word together,

and encourage one another in their spiritual growth journey.

Deacons

Serving with humility and compassion, the
Deacons Ministry is tasked with meeting the
practical needs of our church community, whether it
be through acts of service, assistance with logistical
matters, or providing aid to those in times of crisis.
In all, a nurturing and supportive environment was created
where every member feels loved, cared for, and empowered
to thrive in their walk with Christ.

Key Achievements

- 317 new members joined the church from January 17 to October 28, 2023
- 250 individuals were baptized after being introduced to the elementary teachings of Christ on salvation and baptism
- One new teacher was recruited for the new believers' ministry
- Cell teachings on various topics were prepared by the department
- 40.6% attendance was recorded in cell meetings
- Event encompassed all aspects of the church membership/participants including women, family, youth, intercessors, pastors, leaders, and evangelism

We Educate & Disciple

The Christian Education/Discipleship is committed to nurturing spiritual growth and equipping believers with the knowledge and tools to deepen their relationship with Christ. This department comprises several specialized ministries and units, each designed to cater to the specific needs and stages of spiritual development within our congregation.

Children

Dedicated to laying a strong foundation of faith in the hearts of our youngest members, the church provides engaging and age- appropriate programs that introduce children to the love of Jesus and help them grow in their understanding of biblical truths.

Teens

Focused on guiding adolescents through the challenges of adolescence while strengthening their faith and character, the Teens Team offers relevant teachings, mentorship, and opportunities for teens to connect with God and each other in meaningful ways.

Foundational Class:

Designed for new believers and those seeking to establish a solid foundation in the Christian faith, the Foundational Class provides essential teachings on salvation, baptism, and the fundamental principles of the Christian walk.

iRooted/Maturity Class:

Catering to believers who desire to grow deeper in their faith and spiritual maturity, the Rooted/Maturity Class offers advanced teachings, discipleship resources, and opportunities for deeper fellowship and accountability.

Discovering my Gift Class:

Helping believers identify and develop their spiritual gifts and talents, the Discovering my Gift Class equips individuals to serve effectively in ministry and fulfill their God-given purpose within the body of Christ.

Syllabus Production

A comprehensive curriculum materials, study guides, and resources was designed to facilitate effective teaching and learning experiences across all ministry programs.

In all of this, the Christian Education/Discipleship work tirelessly to provide holistic and transformative discipleship experiences for believers to live out their faith boldly and impact their world for Christ.

Key Achievements

- Provided 85% oversight for sub-departments during plan implementation.
- Offered spiritual and emotional support to subdepartment leaders at a rate of 75% through one-onone interactions with the head of the department.
- Ensured 75% availability of resources for subdepartment activities.
- Trained Health professionals in September 2023
- Conducted weekly bible teachings, vacation bible study, and Christmas celebration achieving 100% participation respectively.
- Edified 100 children during weekly teachings,
 146 during vacation bible study, and 198 during
 Christmas celebration.
- Conducted weekly bible teachings, vacation bible study, and Christmas celebration with participation from 30, 20, and 40 teenagers respectively.
 - Prepared weekly cell teachings.
 - Collaborated with New Believers' ministry to prepare and baptize 250 new members.
- Recruited a new teacher for the ministry.
- The Foursqaure Academy experienced increase in the number of students and teachers and new classes were added and started



The Evangelism, Outreach, and Social Welfare spreads the message of God's love, extending compassion to the marginalized, and meeting the practical needs of our local and global communities. Within this department, several specialized units work tirelessly to fulfill our mandate of proclaiming the Gospel and demonstrating Christ's love through action.

Evangelism Crusades

Engaged in fervent proclamation of the Gospel, the Evangelism Crusades Unit organizes and executes evangelistic campaigns, crusades, and outreach events aimed at reaching the lost and inviting them into a life- transforming relationship with Jesus Christ.

Community Outreaches

Focused on local mission, the Community Outreach seeks to impact our immediate surroundings by meeting tangible needs, offering practical assistance, and fostering relationships with individuals and families in our neighborhoods.

Missions to Foreigners Unit

Committed to fulfilling the Great Commission on a global scale, the Missions to Foreigners reach out to foreign communities, immigrants, and refugees within our city and outside the country, offering support, friendship, and opportunities to encounter the love of Christ.

Charity and Mercy Ministry

Guided by compassion and mercy, the Charity and Mercy extends practical assistance, relief aid, and social support to the vulnerable, disadvantaged, and marginalized members of our society, embodying the love and compassion of Christ in tangible ways.

- Conducted evangelism outreach in Youth conference, women conference, and 40 days prayer and fasting events.
- Successfully implemented radio evangelism through the community outreach unit.
- Social welfare/charity and mercy ministry unit disbursed 6,069,000 RWF to assist the needy, fulfilling their planned activities.
- Paid health insurance for beneficiaries.
- Covered secondary school fees for children.
- Distributed food to various families during festive seasons.
- Provided support and condolences to church members who experienced loss.

Planned activities and events in 2024

- Organize a youth conference, a women conference, and a 40-day prayer and fasting event in 2024.
- Conduct church visitations and followup/coordination activities throughout the year.
- Schedule 4 sub-department meetings for planning and coordination purposes.

- Cover school fees for beneficiaries.

Youth Engagement

In the course of the year, we focused on engaging, equipping, and empowering young people to grow in their faith and live out their calling as Disciples of Christ,



the Youth Ministry provides dynamic programs, events, and discipleship opportunities tailored to the unique needs of adolescents and young adults.

Men's Fellowship

Providing a space for fellowship, encouragement, and growth, the Men's Ministry equips men to lead with integrity, faithfulness, and godly wisdom in their families, workplaces, and communities through mentorship, discipleship, and accountability.

Women's Union Empowering women to flourish in their God-given identity and purpose, the Women's Ministry offers opportunities for spiritual growth, fellowship, and service, creating a supportive community where women can deepen their relationship with Christ and one another.

Couples' and Marriage strengthening provides resources, counseling, and events designed to enrich communication, intimacy, and spiritual unity within marriages, equipping couples to navigate life's challenges with grace and resilience.

The Elderly Fellowship recognizes the value and wisdom of our elderly members, where we honor and support seniors through fellowship, caregiving, and spiritual enrichment, ensuring that they feel cherished, valued, and included in the life of the church community.

Our Family Life focuses on building strong, resilient families and individuals who are rooted in Christ, thriving in community, and equipped to impact the world with God's love.

Key Achievements

- 37 applicants completed all eight sessions in Christian marriage preparation lessons and were successfully wedded.
- A marriage preparation manual was produced and made available in English. It is now translated into Kinyarwanda awaiting review and printing.
- Citylight Foursquare Church now has produced and provided guidelines for weddings for members and non-members.
- Foursquare Family Life Holistic Curriculum encompassing education for various groups like youth, men, women, and newly married couples, with diverse themes was also produced.
- Men Fellowship ably led by Elder MAHIRWE Moise, offered support to church members facing

COMMUNICATION

Communication serves as the vital link between our church and the broader community, facilitating effective communication, engagement, and outreach initiatives. Within this department, a diverse array of ministries and units work together to convey our message with clarity, creativity, and impact. Harnessing the power of visual and digital media through the production of engaging contents, including videos, graphics, and presentations, to enhance worship experiences, share testimonies, and amplify the message of the Gospel across various social media platforms.

We leverage strongly on technology to streamline communication processes and enhance connectivity. Our digital infrastructures, websites, social media platforms and communication tools ensure we deliver seamless communication flow within the church community and beyond.

Our service delivery to foreigners embraces diversity and inclusivity facilitating translation services and resources to effectively communicate the Gospel message to individuals from diverse linguistic



backgrounds, fostering a welcoming and inclusive environment for all.

Our Church branding strategy upholds and enhances the image of Christ in our church. This involves monitoring public perception, managing media relations, and implementing strategies to promote a positive image of our church within the community, fostering trust and credibility.

Our church effectively communicates its mission, values, and activities, fostering connection, engagement, and impact both locally and globally.

Key Achievements



- Streamed all weekly services, totaling 260 services, including 9 overnights.
- Served in Youth Connection, 40 Days of Prayers and Fasting,
 2023 Africa Ignite Connection, 21 Days of Prayers and
 Fasting, and 7 Days of Morning Glory events in 2023.
- Gained 14.7 thousand additional subscribers.
- Reached over 50 countries worldwide through the YouTube Channel, with top countries including Rwanda, United States of America, Kenya, Burundi, Canada, and United Kingdom.
- Church programs were viewed a total of 1,955,770 times in 2023. (27% of the online audience falls between 18 and 24 years old, while 45% are between 25 and 34, and 19.4% are between 35 and 44.)
- Contributed to the sharing of the Gospel on social media platforms.
- Archived videos and photos for church activities (20%).
- Trained and deployed approximately 10 new members.
- Conducted quarterly planning meetings and monthly team prayers.
- Held a Team Retreat with Media and ICT Ministries in September in Rubavu.
- Projected song lyrics and sermons (20%).
- Maintained vMix software for livestreaming.
- Translated Bishop's morning devotions into English (95%).
